## Where Did Tarot Come From?

### A Journey Through Tarot's History

Tarot isn't just a deck of cards—it's a living, breathing tapestry of history, intention, and energy. It has transformed from a medieval card game into the divination tool we know today, shaped by centuries of shared belief and collective magic.

Every card you touch is charged with the focus and intentions of generations of readers, each symbol a reflection of human experiences through time. From its roots in Renaissance courts to the mystical traditions of the Enlightenment and the creativity of the modern age, tarot has absorbed the energies of the people and cultures that shaped it.

Tarot connects us not only to the past but also to the collective wisdom of the present, creating a practice that feels both deeply personal and universally relevant. This isn't just a history

lesson—it's an exploration of the thought forms, ancestral energy, and spiritual power that make tarot so magical.

Playing cards trace their origins to the Tang Dynasty (618–907 AD) in China, where early card-like games used paper as money. By the 13th century, these games traveled along the Silk Road to the Islamic world, where the Mamluk Sultanate of Egypt developed decks with suits like cups, swords, coins, and polo sticks—designs that influenced European playing cards. By 1377, playing cards were widespread in Europe, with variations in structure and purpose. Johannes von Rheinfelden, a Dominican monk, noted their use for both games and moral education, describing decks with four, five, or even six suits.

As playing cards continued to evolve, a distinct type of deck emerged in 15th-century Italy, blending art and allegory. These early decks, known as *Trionfi* (an Italian word meaning "triumphs" or "trumps") laid the foundation for what would later become tarot—a deck that carried not only the spirit of the game but also the seeds of something much deeper.

### **The Renaissance (1400s - 1500s): Foundations of Art and Science**



Life in 14th- and 15th-century Europe was a paradox—simultaneously grounded in faith and reaching for the stars. As the aftermath of the Black Death reshaped society, cities like Florence, Milan, and Venice became hubs of trade, art, and innovation. For the nobility, life was lived in elaborate courts, where wealth and power were displayed through grand artistic commissions—from gilded chapels to painted playing cards. Religion, deeply woven into daily life, offered structure and meaning, while a growing curiosity about the natural world fueled new ways of thinking.

In this cultural explosion, *Trionfi* evolved into *Tarocchi*, a sophisticated card game for the Italian nobility. These decks were luxury objects and symbols of status—each one a masterpiece painstakingly hand-painted, often with gold and silver leaf. The earliest surviving incomplete hand-painted decks from 15th-century Italy were commissioned by the Visconti family, Milan's

ruling dynasty at the time. This tradition was later continued by their successors, the Sforza family. Their trump cards beautifully blend family emblems, such as the Visconti serpent and the Sforza lion, with traditional Trionfi motifs, highlighting the artistry and cultural values of the Renaissance courts.

Amid this surge of creativity, Tarocchi flourished, blending the cultural values of the time with stunning artistry. The Sola-Busca deck, created around 1491, stands as the first complete 78-card tarot deck to survive—a masterpiece that uniquely portrays Roman military figures and classical themes. Though primarily created for an elite card game, these decks reflected the Renaissance fascination with Classical antiquity, allegory, and artistic innovation.

This was the age of da Vinci and Michelangelo, visionaries who redefined art and human understanding. Da Vinci's Vitruvian Man and Mona Lisa embodied the Renaissance ideal of uniting art with scientific observation, while Michelangelo's Sistine Chapel ceiling transformed biblical narratives into transcendent human drama. During this same period, Copernicus's revolutionary theory of a sun-centered universe (published in 1543) laid the groundwork for Galileo's later astronomical discoveries and confrontation with the Church.

Tarot's early story isn't mystical—it's cultural. These cards were born in an age of ambition, faith, and discovery, reflecting a world that dared to dream big while staying deeply rooted in its values.

### **The Enlightenment (1600s - 1700s): Tarot Meets Philosophy**

The Enlightenment, or Age of Reason, was a time when science and logic began to reshape how people understood the world. Thinkers like René Descartes, with his famous phrase "I think, therefore I am," placed reason at the center of knowledge, while scientists like Isaac Newton uncovered natural laws that explained the universe in new ways. During this period, tarot was still primarily a card game, its symbols more decorative than mystical.



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By the late 18th century, however, tarot began its transformation into a tool of deeper meaning. Antoine Court de Gébelin, a French scholar and Freemason, claimed that tarot cards contained hidden wisdom from ancient Egypt. He theorized that the cards were connected to a sacred *Book of Thoth*, a lost text of spiritual truths. Though these claims were not supported by historical evidence, they resonated with Enlightenment thinkers seeking to bridge rationality and mysticism.

Building on Court de Gébelin's ideas, Jean-Baptiste Alliette, better known as "Etteilla," published the first tarot guidebooks and created a deck specifically designed for divination. Etteilla's work laid the foundation for tarot's role as a spiritual tool, blending mystical interpretations with Enlightenment-era curiosity about the unknown.

As Europe moved from superstition to science, tarot evolved with it, shifting from a game of symbols to a practice of introspection. Its imagery, once reflective of rigid hierarchies, became a canvas for personal and philosophical exploration, bridging the gap between reason and mystery.

### **The Industrial Revolution and Romanticism (1800s - Early 1900s): Mysticism in a Modern World**

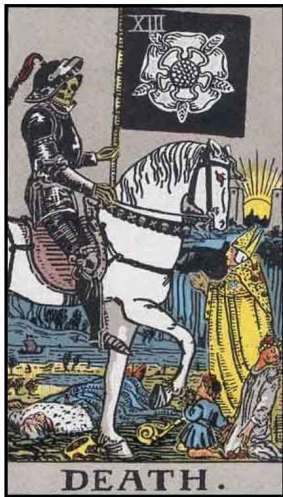

audience. Shortly after, Aleister Crowley and Lady Frieda Harris

introduced the Thoth deck, pushing tarot into even more vibrant and mystical territory.

As the 20th century dawned, tarot became a reflection of its time—balancing ancient wisdom with modern ideas, and offering a bridge between the mysteries of the past and the possibilities of the future.

## Who Reads Tarot?

While ancient pagan traditions have rich spiritual practices that include forms of divination and a deep connection to the spiritual realm, the historical use of tarot cards specifically is not well-documented within these cultures. The association of tarot with the Romani people is largely influenced by external perceptions and stereotypes rather than substantial historical evidence.

Anyone can learn to read tarot cards with dedication and practice. Tarot reading involves understanding symbolism, developing intuition, and honing interpretive skills. Accessible to anyone willing to explore the cards' meanings, tarot serves as a tool for self-reflection, guidance, or even a unique hobby. Whether you're a professional reader or an enthusiast, tarot offers a powerful way to tap into intuition and explore life's questions and challenges.

## What's the Structure of the Deck?

A tarot deck consists of 78 cards, each embodying unique characters and concepts. The deck includes 22 Major Arcana (or Trump cards) symbolizing significant life events, while the remaining 56 Minor Arcana reflect everyday experiences. The Minor Arcana is divided into four suits, each containing ten numbered (PIP) cards and four Court Cards (Pages, Knights, Queens, And Kings).

## What Are the Classic Rules?

While there's no single correct way to read tarot, the Hermetic Order of the Golden Dawn played a significant role in shaping contemporary tarot practice. Founded in the late 19th century, this secret society integrated tarot into its teachings, linking the cards to Kabbalah, astrology, and other mystical systems. Influential members like A.E. Waite and Aleister Crowley further popularized tarot with their decks (Rider-Waite-Smith and Thoth), which remain widely used and studied today.

Classic interpretations create a foundation that ensures continuity across readings, but it's natural to develop your own interpretations over time. Trusting your intuition is ultimately the "correct" answer. My decks and training programs are based on these traditional frameworks, allowing you to build a strong foundation and, when ready, adapt tarot to your unique insights.

## PART 2: ESSENTIALS OF TAROT

### Tarot is a Story—That’s Why It’s Called a Reading

People come to a tarot reading seeking a glimpse into what’s ahead. A tarot reader guides them by examining the past, present, and potential futures. The cards, drawn randomly, present fate with 78 different personalities, moods, motivations, and outcomes, each brought into the spotlight. The querent then interprets each card to see how it mirrors their life, often revealing insights they may not have considered before.

Through this process, the reader not only suggests possible outcomes but also encourages the querent to reflect on why each card has appeared for them. This reflection shapes their desires and goals. In fact, the very act of predicting the future can start to change it—because with fresh insights, we often adjust our actions to influence the outcomes we hope for.

Stories are how we find ourselves; they help us connect with others and see our own experiences reflected back to us. Since time began, we’ve passed down stories to learn, to warn, and to share life’s most essential messages. A tarot reading is called a "reading" because it tells a story—the most important story of all: the querent’s own.

A compelling story needs a “what.” A good story also has a “who” and a “when.” But a truly satisfying story has a “why”... and a “what’s next.” In the coming pages, we’ll explore how to use century-old meanings—including archetypes, numerology, astrology, and intuition—to help you create these essential story elements in your tarot readings. But how do you move beyond memorizing meanings so you can focus on the story, not the guidebook? That’s where the 5 Golden Rings of Tarot come in.

### The 5 Golden Rings of Tarot Reading

The 5 Golden Rings are essential techniques that unlock the deeper complexities of tarot reading, and the Talking Tarot Deck is specifically designed to make them easy to apply. Tarot can seem overwhelming, with its intricate layers of classic meanings, archetypes, numerology,

astrology, and intuitive insights. However, with the Talking Tarot Deck and these Golden Rings as your guide, you'll confidently incorporate these powerful techniques without relying on constant memorization.

Each Golden Ring represents a technique or approach that simplifies and clarifies an essential tarot element:

1. **Classic Meanings and Archetypes**
2. **Classic Elements (Earth, Air, Water, and Fire)**
3. **Numerology**
4. **Astrology**
5. **Intuition**

With the 5 Golden Rings and the Talking Tarot Deck as your tools, tarot becomes a seamless, intuitive story. These techniques, along with the deck's thoughtful design, allow you to access tarot's deeper layers and bring each card's message to life—without constantly reaching for a guidebook. Each reading becomes an insightful, flowing experience that taps into the wisdom already within you.

## **Golden Ring #1: Meanings and Archetypes**

### **Knowing Who and What Your Tarot Story Is About**

To read a story from your tarot spread, you must first identify the key figures or events involved. Often, the querent (the person receiving the reading) already senses who or what the spread's themes might be once they understand each card's meaning—but they rely on the reader to bring these connections to light. The Talking Tarot Deck simplifies this process: each card includes a QR code that links to a video narrated by the card's character, bringing the card's meaning to life and inviting the querent to reflect on how it personally applies to them.

Each of the 78 tarot cards represents a unique meaning and archetype (or character) that becomes easily recognizable with practice. However, learning to read tarot in under an hour—



without memorizing each card or constantly referring to a guidebook—requires the right deck. Many cards also indicate a yes or no answer or suggest directionality, showing whether a card relates more to the past, present, or future, or even pointing to a specific adjacent card in a multi-card spread. This level of detail can be challenging to keep in mind, which is why the Talking Tarot Deck uses symbols that make these elements instantly clear, eliminating the need for memorization.

While the Rider-Waite-Smith deck is widely recommended for beginners due to its rich symbolism and vibrant colors, its classic style relies heavily on the reader's understanding of traditional depictions, which may not resonate with modern readers. Therefore, I don't recommend it as a starter deck unless the reader is prepared to memorize meanings, which typically takes more than an hour.

When I first started reading tarot, I searched for a deck that included subtle cues in the artwork—cues to discreetly help me recall each card's meaning. Unable to find one, I improvised by writing keywords on each card with a marker. This approach was effective for learning but wasn't ideal for reading confidently for others, and it took hundreds of hours. This experience ultimately inspired me to create my first published deck, *The Lightworker's Deck*, and later, *The Talking Tarot Deck*. Both incorporate keywords directly into the design: upright keywords show the core meaning, while inverted (upside-down) meanings are visible when the card is drawn reversed. This setup eliminates the need for memorization and helps prevent readers from going blank.

Whether you choose to read intuitively based on the art and symbolism or use a deck with built-in keywords and symbols, there are techniques that make it easy to understand the cards without referring to a guidebook. For example, some cards are gendered or depict age, but these traits are symbolic. Masculine and feminine qualities, as well as varying levels of maturity, exist within everyone. All cards depict either people or events, and Court Cards, in particular, often represent key figures in a reading. Here's a quick guide to their character clues:

- Pages – Child or Young Adult, Any Gender, Feminine

- Knights – Young Adult, Masculine
- Queens – Mature Adult, Feminine
- Kings – Mature Adult, Masculine

For reference, the last part of this book includes a chart summarizing the meaning and archetype of each tarot card.

## Golden Ring #2: Classic Elements

Understanding the classic elements assigned to each card helps you quickly connect to its core meaning—whether it involves thinking (air), doing (fire), feeling (water), or securing (earth). Each element corresponds to specific qualities and motivations, represented with unique symbols in my tarot decks. The Talking Tarot Deck also includes a 79th “wild card,” which serves as a guide to the symbols, including the classic elements.

- **Suit of Wands and Kings**

**Element: Fire**

Meaning: Doing, driven by action and desire

Fire is associated with action, motivation, and movement. Often represented by red or yellow, it embodies the part of the story that involves desire and physical action. Both the suit of wands and all four kings fall under this element, highlighting the energy and drive behind intentions.

- **Suit of Coins and Pages**

**Element: Earth**

Meaning: Securing, driven by responsibility and stability

Earth represents the need for security, responsibility, and dependability. Typically shown in green or brown, it addresses aspects of the story related to physical security and obligations. Both the suit of coins and all four pages are aligned with earth, emphasizing the grounded, practical motivations.

- **Suit of Swords and Knights**

**Element: Air**

Meaning: Thinking, driven by logic and intellect

Air symbolizes thought, intellect, and strategy, often represented by white, blue, or purple. Cards in this element focus on the intellectual and strategic layers of the story. Both the suit of swords and all four knights align with air, illustrating the cerebral aspects of decision-making.

- **Suit of Cups and Queens**

**Element: Water**

Meaning: Feeling, driven by love and emotion

Water represents emotions and intuition, typically depicted in blue. It encompasses the emotional side of the story, reflecting how people feel or have felt. The suit of cups and all four queens are associated with water, bringing in themes of love, emotions, and sensitivity.

By understanding these elemental associations, you can connect to each card's core meaning with ease, adding depth and richness to your readings without needing to memorize details.

## **Alternate Interpretations with Court Cards**

In tarot, the alignment of elements with court cards is a topic of ongoing debate among experts. For the Talking Tarot Deck, I chose the classic elemental associations often linked to the Golden Dawn tradition from the early 20th century: Kings with Fire, Pages with Earth, Knights with Air, and Queens with Water. Each court card in this deck includes these symbols for easy reference, aligning with a widely accepted framework that many readers find effective.

However, my previous decks—The Lightworker's Deck and The Star Kissed Tarot Deck—use an alternate interpretation: Pages with Air, Knights with Fire, Queens with Water, and Kings with Earth. In this approach:

- Pages (curious and fresh) align with Air
- Knights (bold and action-oriented) align with Fire
- Queens (nurturing and empathetic) align with Water
- Kings (stable and responsible) align with Earth

This alternate framework resonates with different aspects of each card’s qualities, and both interpretations are equally valid. There’s no single “right” way to read tarot—the cards will communicate through the elemental associations that feel most natural to you. The Talking Tarot Deck invites you to explore these interpretations and trust your intuition, allowing the cards to speak to you in the way that aligns with your unique reading style.

### Golden Ring #3: Numerology

Numerology in tarot reflects the stages of a journey, with each number corresponding to a specific phase or level of maturity. In the Major Arcana, the journey begins with The Fool (0) and concludes with The World (21), with each step representing a progression in the narrative. In the Minor Arcana, each suit has ten numbered cards (known as PIP cards) and four Court Cards (Pages, Knights, Queens, and Kings), with each card’s position representing a unique stage in life.

Each numbered card in the deck, especially in the Minor Arcana, captures a different phase of life’s journey—from inception to completion. Lower numbers reflect beginning stages, while higher numbers indicate a phase approaching completion. Here’s a quick guide:

#### **The Beginning: New, Childhood, Childlike**

This stage represents the uncertainty and potential that come with starting something new. In Tarot-Astrology, this phase is called “Cardinal,” symbolized by “C” on the Talking Tarot Deck in the lower right corner of the card.

- **Aces:** Indicate a new beginning with potential.
- **Twos:** Suggest it’s time to make a choice.

- **Threes:** Mark a period of growth.
- **Fours:** Encourage evaluating your current position and its alignment with your priorities.
- **Queens:** Represent a time of powerful emotions or feelings.

### **The Middle: Growth, Development, Maturation**

This stage signifies development, where things may seem steady, yet change is inevitable. Called the “Fixed” phase in Tarot-Astrology, it’s marked by “F” on the card’s lower right corner.

- **Fives:** Reflect struggle or challenge.
- **Sixes:** Represent finding balance amid challenges.
- **Sevens:** Prompt reflection on beliefs and principles.
- **Knights:** Indicate times of action, movement, or change.

### **The End: Completion, Transition, Wisdom**

The final stage deals with closure and letting go. Known as the “Mutable” phase in Tarot-Astrology, it’s identified by “M” on the card’s lower right corner.

- **Eights:** Indicate a path toward expertise or mastery.
- **Nines:** Reflect consequences of past actions.
- **Tens:** Signal the end of a cycle and the beginning of another.
- **Kings:** Represent maturity, leadership, and authority.

### **Using Advanced Numerology**

Advanced numerology offers additional insights by linking numbers to phases in the story of each tarot spread. Each single-digit number from 0 to 9 holds unique meaning:

**0 - Potential:** The blank slate before beginnings.

**1 - Beginnings:** New starts and initiations.

**2 - Union:** Partnerships, balance, and connection.

- 3 - Progress:** Growth and personal development.
- 4 - Structure:** Building stability and strong foundations.
- 5 - Forging:** Change, adaptation, and transformation.
- 6 - Harmony:** Balance, peace, and equilibrium.
- 7 - Awareness:** Introspection and enlightenment.
- 8 - Power:** Strength, control, and willpower.
- 9 - Fulfillment:** Completion, satisfaction, and achievement.

For numbers greater than 9, we apply **numerical reduction** by adding individual digits to reduce them to a single-digit essence. This simplified approach helps larger numbers align with core numerology. For instance:

**10** becomes **1** ( $1 + 0$ ).

**16** becomes **7** ( $1 + 6$ ).

**18** becomes **9** ( $1 + 8$ ).

**19** becomes **10**, which reduces to **1** ( $1 + 0$ ).

This method distills larger numbers, revealing the core essence of their single-digit counterparts and helping you connect with the fundamental meanings in each spread.

## Golden Ring #4: Astrology

### Integrating Astrology into Tarot

Incorporating astrology into tarot deepens and personalizes readings, connecting card symbolism with astrological insights. Zodiac signs that emerge during a reading may not indicate someone's sun sign directly but represent characteristics influenced by their sun, moon, or rising signs. Each zodiac sign brings unique traits that contribute to the narrative of a tarot

reading. Here's a quick breakdown of zodiac qualities, organized by element, for easier reference:



The Talking Tarot Deck includes symbols to identify these zodiac traits directly on the cards, and the deck's 79th "wild" card offers a quick reference to these qualities.

## **PLANETS**

Planets play a significant role in tarot, with specific cards traditionally associated with certain planets. Tarot practitioners of the late 1800s based meanings on the seven classical planets visible from Earth, and each planet adds unique layers of meaning. The Talking Tarot Deck uses symbols for these associations: traditional symbols for classical planets and modern scientific symbols for newer planets.

### **Classical Planets and Their Meanings:**

Each of the seven classical planets observed from Earth provides distinct influence:

- **Sun ☉ – Confidence:** Embodies vitality, self-expression, and inner light, encouraging confidence and positivity.
- **Mercury ☿ – Strategy:** Represents intellect, communication, and strategy, guiding decisions and interactions.

Some cards are not associated with specific planetary influences but represent the Universe’s interconnectedness and the collective whole. These universal cards remind readers to see beyond individual influences, focusing on the broader forces guiding our paths.

Our "second brain," the gut, houses around 100 million neurons in a complex network known as the enteric nervous system. Connected closely to the brain, this network often plays a role in the intuitive responses we call "gut feelings." Sensations like butterflies or discomfort in the stomach can signal thoughts, decisions, or situations needing attention. This phenomenon is part of our nervous system processing sensory information, detecting subtle cues, and making rapid subconscious assessments—all informed by past experiences and emotional patterns—before we consciously become aware of them.

Intuition, however, is just one piece of the puzzle. Equally crucial is imagination, the creative exploration of possibilities that intuition introduces. Imagination is instinctual for children and comes naturally to some adults, particularly empaths and psychics, yet many of us lose touch with it over time. While general readings offer broad insights, specific questions often yield more focused guidance. Encourage querents to center their questions on particular areas of interest or concern—such as relationships, career, or personal growth. For example, asking “How can I achieve greater satisfaction in my career?” directs the reading to insights that are more tailored to the querent’s needs.

Each tarot card holds a question within itself—a question to the querent’s question. Articulating your thoughts often reveals hidden insights and clears mental blocks. Speaking out loud can connect you back to the story the cards are telling.

3. **Trust Your Intuition:**

Self-doubt is one of the quickest ways to diminish intuitive clarity. Trusting in your insights is key to maintaining authentic and meaningful readings.

Remember, moments of blankness don't signify failure; they're simply an invitation to refocus and trust in your own abilities. By approaching each reading with patience and self-assurance, you strengthen your connection to the cards and to your intuitive voice.

## **Understanding Tarot Spreads**

In tarot, a "spread" is the specific arrangement of cards in a reading. Each card's position within the spread holds a unique meaning, shaping how the overall story is interpreted. The number of

cards in a spread often determines the reading's depth; a single card offers a quick insight, while more complex spreads, like those with five or ten cards, allow for a richer, more layered story.

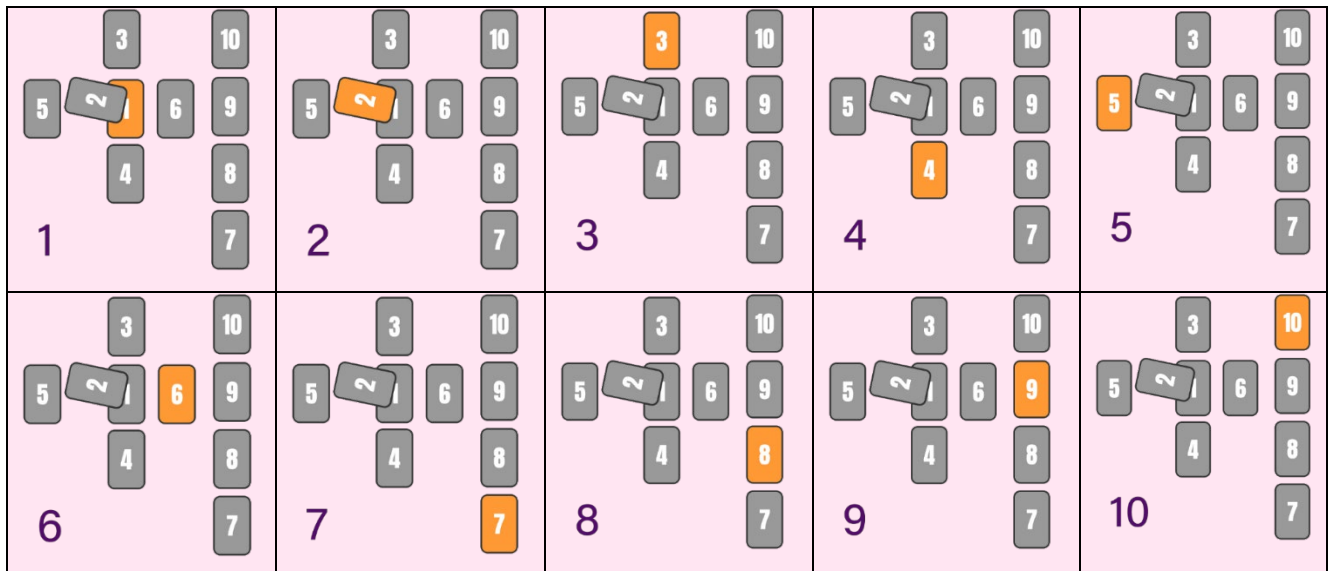

- **Some – Subconscious**
- **Pretty – Past**
- **Fun –Future**
- **Magic –Mindset**
- **Except – External**
- **When –Want or Fear**
- **Pouting – Potential**

With this range of beliefs, a reader must be prepared to meet diverse expectations and occasionally recognize when certain querents may not be the right fit for a Tarot reading. This includes respecting different degrees of belief and skepticism and adapting to each querent's unique perspective. However, there are some situations where it's best to refer a querent to another type of support.

### Types of Querents to Handle Carefully
